*Remember Worship is at Immanuel.... Jan. 31<sup>st</sup> at 9:30AM.*

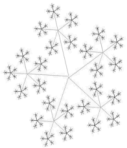
*Directions to Immanuel... Take 14 East to County Road #25 (go about 5 miles)*
