Sunday School Goals:

- U Engage our children in meaningful study of God's Word
- U Learn many of the major stories of the Old and New Testament and see God's plan of salvation in Christ
- U Connect God's Word to the daily lives of our young people

Classes:

Jesus and Me: For ages 2-3. Allows parents to encourage and nurture their children as they learn about Jesus together. Classes meet in the room to the right of the preschool room.

Preschool: All children ages 3 to 5 who are able to participate in the class can be enrolled. The children should be brought to the classroom and picked up by a parent or adult.

Rotation Sunday School: For youth in Kindergarten through Grade 8. There are now home rooms for the classes:

Grades K/1/2: Two rooms to the left of the upstairs bathrooms.

Grades 3/4/5: Three rooms to the left of the upstairs bathrooms.

Grades 6/7/8: Library. The students can meet in their homeroom prior to going to opening in the church sanctuary.

October Rotation Sunday School

--Our September studies continued with the story of Moses and the Israelites in the wilderness on their way to the promised land. The Sunday school students learned about "Worship in the Tabernacle" and the older students were able to construct a scale model of the Tabernacle.

--Our next unit will be "The Twelve Spies in Canaan." Students will be going on a spy hunt and will learn that we need to put our trust in God and not in ourselves.

- Build schools in India
- Teach Russian children about Jesus

The Sunday school children will learn about the country of Cambodia in our next rotation!
